El Dorado County Leash Law

Loose dogs continue to harass the neighbors in the District. There have been reports of dangerous German Shepherds and pit bulls harassing livestock and chasing people walking, biking and riding horses. We would like to remind all residents that according to El Dorado County Ordinance Code Title 6, Chapter 6.12 Section 6.12.070 - **Running at large prohibited** (in part, look it up if you wish to see the full version): "No person owning or having control of any animal [...] shall permit such animal [...] to stray or run at large upon any...unenclosed private lot or other unenclosed private place in the County [...]" **Please keep your dogs confined at home and on leash while walking them.**
